High School Honors Program Application

MISSION To work with like-minded Christian parents to educate our children with love and mercy in a godly environment that emphasizes a rigorously biblical curriculum, Christian character training, and college preparatory academics.

VISION To produce well-rounded, self-governed leaders who apply the Word of God to every area of thought and life.

Honors Program Entrance Requirements:

- Entering 10th-12th grade in the upcoming school year.
- Cumulative high school GPA of 3.5 or above.
- Submit the application and essay by **August 20, 2024**.

Honors Program Content:

Program requirements and scholarships are subject to change from year to year.

Scholarship:

Students who complete all Honors Program requirements for the year will receive a \$1,000 tuition scholarship at our Awards Assembly in May.

Academics:

Complete available Honors level courses in Bible, History, English, and Science.

- The Honors level course designation requires the student to complete 1 additional essay or project and 1 additional book related to each class per year, according to the teacher's direction.
- **Bible** Honors Courses: Complete the 3 courses offered in the rotation for those years.
- **History** and **English** Honors Course Pairs:
 - 10th Grade: Complete either U.S. History/American Literature or Church History/British Literature based on what is offered that year.
 - 11th/12th Grades: Complete both World History/World Literature and Government and Economics/Expository Writing.
- **Science** Honors Course:
 - 10th Grade: Complete an essay or project and a book related to Biology.
 - 11th/12th Grades: Complete both Chemistry and Physics.

Community Service and Leadership:

- Complete 25 hours of service per year.
- Assume one of the follow leadership roles for at least one school year: Governance, Yearbook Chair, Field Day Captain, or other approved leadership role.

 - Ways you hope to improve in each area in the coming school year.
